

**A CALL FOR NOMINATIONS
(NOTICE BY PUBLICATION OF)**

32-1-804.1; 32-1-804.3, 1-1-104(34), 32-1-905(2), C.R.S.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN, and, particularly, to the electors of the Woodmen Valley Fire Protection District of El Paso County, Colorado.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a coordinated election with El Paso County will be held on the 4TH day of May, 2010, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. At that time, two (2) directors will be elected to serve 4-year terms and no directors will be elected to serve 2-year * terms. Eligible electors of the Woodmen Valley Fire Protection District interested in serving on the board of directors may obtain a Self-Nomination and Acceptance form from the District Designated Election Official (DEO):

If the DEO determines that a Self-Nomination and Acceptance form is not sufficient, the eligible elector who submitted the form may amend the form once, at any time, prior to 3:00 p.m. on Friday, February 26, 2010. The deadline to submit a Self-Nomination and Acceptance is close of business on **Friday, February 26, 2010** (not less than 67 days before the election). Earlier submittal is encouraged as the deadline will not permit curing an insufficient form. Affidavit of Intent To Be A Write-In-Candidate forms must be submitted to the office of the designated election official by the close of business on Monday, March 1, 2010 (the sixty-fourth day before the election).

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, an application for a mail-in ballot shall be filed with the designated election official no later than the close of business on **Friday, April 30, 2010**, except that, if the applicant wishes to receive the mail-in ballot by mail, the application shall be filed no later than the close of business on **Tuesday, April 27, 2010**.

PROCEDURAL INSTRUCTIONS: This is a sample form only. Review use with your attorney. For Regular Elections, the "Call for Nominations" is to be published not less than 75 days nor more than 90 days before election, per C.R.S. 32-1-804.1. In addition, C.R.S. 1-1-104(34) defines 'publication' as *printing one time, in a newspaper of general circulation in the[special district if there is such a newspaper, and if not, then in a newspaper in the county in which the special district is located.* Districts in more than one county should review the complete definition. * Use **only** if a vacancy on your board was filled by appointment: . . . *[an appointee is] to serve until the next regular election, at which time, the vacancy shall be filled by election for any remaining unexpired portion of the term.* C.R.S. 32-1-905(2)(a).
